Did You Know !!!

- ◆ Cedar Lake is our facility! We own it, pay the mortgage & utilities, and maintain it.
- ◆ Each week over 1,000 people walk through our doors to attend meetings.
- ◆ The facility's average operating budget is typically around \$55,000 per year.
- ◆ We provide a "Tool Box" (bookstore) that offers a variety of recovery materials.
- ◆ Cedar Lake will spend an estimated \$15,000 on coffee and supplies in 2013.
- ◆ There are 38 regularly scheduled meetings provided during the 7-day week.
- ◆ The utility and insurance expenses average about \$780.00 per month.
- ◆ CLF budgets \$5,000 to \$7,000 per year for facility upgrades and maintenance.
- ◆ Meeting rent, member dues and coffee donations provide for 85% of our revenue.

It is our belief that recovery is a lifetime process and these facilities are provided to the community voluntarily by the members and supporters of this objective.

What Does CLF Do?

Cedar Lake Fellowship provides a meeting place for recovering members of Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, Cocaine Anonymous and Alanon. CLF is also open to consider accommodating other 12-step programs.

Who Can Join?

Anyone is eligible for membership who attends Cedar Lake. Are members are people who belong to and regularly attend Twelve Step meetings.

Are There Privileges to Being a Member?

The main privilege of membership is a pride in knowing you have an active part in supporting this fellowship. Without your help, we could not function. There are other small privileges such as a spot to hang a coffee cup, and your name being displayed on the membership board.

How Much Are Membership Dues?

Membership dues are \$5.00 per month, or \$60.00 for an entire year. We ask you consider the dues as a small insurance policy that assures you continue to have a safe place to meet.

What Can I Do To Help?

Because we are a recognized Not-For-Profit organization, we rely on contributions in the form of dues from participating members and meeting rent to finance the operation of this facility. In the past, there have been community contributions, but we depend heavily on the membership funds and rent income to pay the mortgage and all the other costs associated with operating the facility. You are not required to be a member of CLF to participate in meetings at Cedar Lake however,
